SYNOPSIS

Created by Stefo Nantsou through extensive drama workshops in a number of regional and remote high schools in 2003, *The Forwards* is a tragic-comedy about friendship, alcohol-fuelled sporting culture and small town rivalries.

The Forwards is directed by Zeal Theatre's artistic director Stefo Nantsou and stars Sam Foster, Hayden Jones and Ellen Bailey.

It was published by Playlab in 2009.

Three actors take the audience through a whirlwind of emotions, as the show follows the story of a small town called "Pintoon" where nothing ever happens.... except the footy! The town is buzzing as the "Pintoon Parrots" finally make it to the Grand Final. Tensions boil over in the build up to the big game, leading to some devastating repercussions for the whole town. Each actor plays a number of characters from the town including the 3 star "forwards", Hoges, Tractor and Gary Rabbit. The story is told through the eyes of Julie Carter, who is "Rabbit's" girlfriend, with both roles being played by the same actress (Ellen Bailey).

A live musical score, performed by onstage musicians along with the 3 actors, complements

the high-octane physical action. *The Forwards* is a superb example of Zeal's signature style of theatre, utilizing physical theatre, live music and multiple characters.

A season of *The Forwards* was presented at The Arts Centre Gold Coast in July 2015. After this season a schools touring version of the show toured to several schools throughout SE Qld.

Previous schools touring versions of *The Forwards* have toured with Queensland Arts Council and Regional Arts Victoria.

AUDIENCE ENGAGEMENT

OVERVIEW

The Forwards was inspired by true stories and people from regional communities. This allows for community to connect with the show on a deeply personal level. Hopefully the events and characters in the show are easily identifiable and relatable for the audience creating a meaningful engagement between audience and performer.

Zeal Theatre Qld have extensive experience in workshop facilitation and performances of *The Forwards* can we accompanied by a workshop or masterclass. Workshops can be in delivered in physical theatre, devising theatre and characterisation.

The Forwards explores several themes and issues that are relevant to many regional communities. Zeal Theatre Qld can facilitate a community forum discussing these themes and issues upon request from the venue.

Zeal Theatre Qld also offers another production, *The Apology* which could be performed as a double bill with *The Forwards* or during the daytime for high school students. This would increase the contribution to the community while keeping the cost for the venue down.

WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION/DETAILS

Workshops are available in a range of areas including:

- Physical Theatre and Movement
- Character Development and Multiple Characters
- Devising Theatre and Play Building
- Monologues
- Improvisation
- Shakespeare
- · Brechtian Techniques

These workshops can be catered to the specific needs of the participants and are suitable for all skill levels from novice to professional.

Duration of workshops can vary depending on request from the participants.

- 60 90 mins
- Half day
- · Full day
- Weekend

MAXIMUM NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS PER WORKSHOP:

30 people

ARTIST IN RESIDENCIES

As well as one off workshops, Zeal Qld offer "Artist in Residencies". These residencies can run for anywhere between 1 week and 1 month and have the option of culminating in a community performance outcome or a "work in progress" showing.

COST

Cost of workshops and Artist in Residence are a flat rate for venue. These costs vary depending on duration of workshop and length of residency.

AN EXAMPLE OF PRICING IS:

- 90 min workshop = \$350
- 1 week Artist in Residency (2 artists) = \$3000

"The piece is 'lifted' by its theatricality. It's not a bunch of characters sitting around talking about 'their problems'. It's people doing what they do... kicking a ball, dancing to a band down the pub, going to parties, being in dangerous situations, holding secrets, cheating, gambling, raising hopes and disappointing loved ones", writer and director Stefo Nantsou explains

"I think the mobile phone and social media mania has magnified the theatre experience. People are just not used to live performance anymore and their place in it, that they are a participant. People are so disconnected from the reality around them that when they see a live performance on stage it can be very confronting and a powerful experience".

STORYLINE

In the small town of Pintoon everyone loves the footy. The local team, the Pintoon Parrots, finally make it to the grand final due to the talent of their three star goal kickers, Rabbit, Hoges and Tractor. Before the big game, the entire town is partying hard and the 'dream team' are challenged by the vicious cocktail of grog and jealousy as mateship gives way to anger and violence.

The Forwards looks at the pressures on young people to balance their sporting skills, hopes and



dreams, with a culture of binge drinking, racing cars and small town rivalries. Zeal Theatre's internationally renowned style of physical theatre makes this an unforgettable experience.

Previous marketing strategies have included newspaper, magazine, radio interviews and online advertising. We have worked with a publicist in the past to assist in reaching these key media contacts.

Previous reviews of the show and also radio, print and online reviews once the show has opening at a venue has also been a very effective form of marketing.

The target audience would be 15-45 years olds but is by no means limited to this demographic. Due to the sporting content of the show there is a potential to market the show to sporting clubs and organisations (especially AFL clubs). We approached several clubs during our 2015 season at the Arts Centre Gold Coast with some successful outcomes, including a write up in a local footy clubs newsletter.

Schools groups were also a key market for us to target. Due to the reputation and success of Zeal Theatre in high schools throughout Qld this continues to be a key market for all our productions.
