SYNOPSIS

Do you believe in the power of IMAGINATION?

The Magic Garden is a fun-fuelled interactive journey of exploration and creativity for families. Join "Pat Malone", a bush adventurer and Mythical Creature Researcher as he embarks on specialized research into Autonomous Imaginary Species, or A.I.S. These are creatures that begin in the imagination, or in the collective consciousness, and then become real, physical creatures that have a life all of their own! Now, it might sound crazy and I bet you're wondering how it's possible...

Along the way, you will meet mythical Australian creatures, observe them in their habitat, be mesmerised by their physicality, and laugh out loud as each has a physical encounter with Pat.

Inspired by classic family fantasy stories like "The Neverending Story" and "Alice in Wonderland", Shock Therapy have fused Physical Theatre, Slapstick and the good old aussie yarn to create a colourful and iconic piece about the nature of reality and the power of the mind over matter.

PERFORMANCE SPECIFICS

PROMENADE/ SITE SPECIFIC SHOW

Give us a site and we will transform it into a world full of hidden magic and inter-dimensional discoveries! The audience will be led by Pat on an exploration of the site, using the power of BELIEF to find Autonomous Imaginary Species to play with and learn about. Running time 30 – 45mins

STAGE SHOW

This version of *The Magic Garden* is the same hilarious and whacky adventure, told in a traditional stage show format, designed for stages, theatres and school touring with a running time of 45minutes.



CREATURE WORKSHOP (OPTIONAL)

The Magic Garden takes a whole new twist as kids are invited to become a 'creature' too! In the creature-making workshop, kids can transform themselves into their own mythical creature, using a range of supplied materials including cardboard, rope, paper cups, fabrics and bamboo.

With the help of talented artists from Shock Therapy Productions and shaped by their imaginations, kids can make their very own set of wings, a mask, fins or a pair of claws.

Dressed as their mythical creature, kids will be invited to bring their creature to life as they participate in a Physical Theatre workshop lead by the cast of *The Magic Garden*.

Total duration for Creature Making and Physical Movement workshop:

30 - 60 minutes.

DURATION

30 – 90mins (depending on format and clients needs)

SUITABLE VENUES

Promenade site specific show: Tailored to suit the surrounds. Power required for basic audio and evening performances require power for basic lighting. Works best if there are trees and shrubbery, and some water nearby.

Stage show: This show is suitable for most venues. Minimum stage dimensions are 5m wide x 5m deep x 3m high. Access to power outlet required.

Maximum number of performances per week: 10 performances

Minimum break between performances: 60 minutes

TECHNICAL SUMMARY

The technical requirements for *The Magic Garden* are minimal. Daytime performances don't require lighting however power is required for a simple audio set up. Evening performances will require 3 phase power for basic lighting. We are happy to negotiate technical requirements on a site by site basis.

EXAMPLE SCHEDULE

Promenade Site Specific Show:

A tour of the site will need to take place a minimum of 1 week prior to the performance, and a minimum of 1 day on-site rehearsal prior to the performance.

Stage Show:

1 hour bump in.

Crew Required:

Minimal crew required from the venue. 1 person to provide access to space, power supply, dressing rooms.

MINIMUM STAGE DIMENSIONS

5m wide x 5m deep x 3m high

SHOCK THERAPY TO SUPPLY

All set, props and costumes.

VENUE TO SUPPLY

Access to 240V power supply.

- 4-6 x LED pars on portable lighting trees that can be used outdoors.
