PRESENTS: VIRAL WRITTEN BY SAM FOSTER AND HAYDEN JONES

#### PRODUCTION OVERVIEW

Viral is a new work written and devised by Sam Foster and Hayden Jones, Co-Founders of Shock Therapy Productions. It explores the role of social media and technology and how it impacts the way we record, communicate and think about events of racism, abuse, violence and sexual assault in the community. It explores the line between disassociation and raising awareness about such events, asking the question "is it better to record these activities and post it on the Internet or step in and stop it from occurring in the first place"?

Viral was inspired by a number of true events and broader societal changes facing Gold Coasters and the wider community. During the development of Viral, Hayden Jones and Sam Foster have engaged with various demographics and cultural groups on the Gold Coast, to hear a diverse cross-section of perspectives concerning the themes and issues in the play. This will involved contacting and actively reaching out to groups and individuals interested in sharing their insights.

The play fuses physical theatre, verbatim style text, AV projections and political theatre as it explores the issues around technology and documenting and sharing events and how it is impacting our lives. It looks are the role of the "bystander" in the modern age and the effects of living in an overly litigious society where everyone has access to a recording device that can broadcast every interaction to the entire World. *Viral* also explores desensitization, responsibility and the role of social media.

Viral was presented at the Arts Centre Gold Coast in September, 2016.

Viral was nominated for 4 Matilda Awards in 2016 (Best Independent Production, Best New Australian Work, Best Actor – Sam Foster and Best AV Design)

The production won the 2016 Matilda for Best Independent Production.

## **TECHNICAL INFO**

The technical requirements for *Viral* are minimal. The show can be adapted to fit into most spaces and uses minimum AV, lighting or sound FX that would easily be operated by one LX operator.

All AV and sound cues operated through Q-lab.

The set is small and portable and can be bumped in and out of the venue in a short time (4 hrs)

Viral was part of the Arts Centre Gold Coast 2016 program and premiered in "The Space" in September 2016. In addition to this main stage version of the show, a smaller, scaled down version of Viral is currently touring Qld schools.

As part of the Creative Development of *Viral* a public community forum was held at The Arts Centre Gold Coast on the 19th May 2016. We invited various cultural and community leaders to a facilitated forum, to openly share and discuss these issues and the themes of the production. The forum was facilitated by, City of Redlands Councilor and founder of Arts Evolution, Cr Paul Bishop.
